Step 1: Select a Location.

- If you were to implement this project, what SPECIFIC community would you like to impact? It could be demographic or geographic.
- Brainstorm a list of places and then select one.

Step 2: Psychological Terms

- When you think of your project, what terms, studies, or lessons come to mind? What activities have we done relate to your project?
- Brainstorm as many as possible.

Step 3: Think about which question you are answering:

- Are we using evidence from psychological studies to provide support for change? Are we implementing a tool already created to impact this social issue?
- Research if there is any connection between psychology and your social issue on the internet.
- Correctly cite at least one source.

Step 4: Select and Define your ONE psychological term

- Choose one term/study/lesson/etc. From your brainstorm.
- Research the definition of this term.
- Correctly cite the source.

Step 5: Connect that one term to the question you are answering

- Write a paragraph connecting the term/study/lesson/activity you selected to the question you are answering.
- Incorporate how this relates or connects to the location you selected

Step 6: Submission

- Include a picture of your brainstorm process
- Write one paragraph about what your psychological concept is and what it means
- Write out the question you are trying to answer and a paragraph of how that connects to your term
- Correctly cite in APA the two sources you found
